Christoph Probst (+ 1943) was a university student in Munich and a member of the White Rose movement, an underground resistance movement to Nazi regime. Before being put to death he was received into the Catholic Church.

My dearest sister: Saturday, as I was going to pick up my pass to go to Tegernsee, I was arrested and taken to Munich. Now for the first time in my life I'm sitting in a cell and do not know what tomorrow will bring. But being in prison isn't as bad as I thought, and I'm glad that I haven't lost my piece of mind; in fact, I'm often in very good spirits. Don't worry my dear, and have no anxiety for me. My little sister, you dear half of my life and being don't be distressed—it isn't worthwhile. Don't be sad or despairing. One does not fashion one's own fate, and can do nothing but bear it. I see your warm brown eyes (which had better not be wet with tears), I see your lovely face, from which so much love always shines out to me. And I see your whole image before me, I feel much more than words can tell, and then my heart runs over.

[Dear Mother:] I thank you for having given me life. When I really think it through, it has all being a single road to God. Do not grieve that I must now skip the last part of it. Soon I shall be closer to you than before. In the meantime I'll prepare a glorious reception for you all.

I never knew that dying is so easy. I die without any feeling of hatred. Never forget that life is nothing but a growing in love and a preparation for eternity.
